SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS


The Mario Ambrosino Marathon is a closed event conducted under the competition rules of The Power Dinghy Racing Club of WA.

The Race Director may make a ruling on any matter not specifically covered by the competition rules or supplementary regulations contained in this publication. The Mario Ambrosino Marathon is round 3 of the Club State Championship and will carry points as per rule 1822. Finishing order will be used to determine start positions for this years Nannup Cup.

All turn boats must be rounded correctly as the race identification numbers will be recorded by all turn boats. Comprehensive course details will be provided at briefing. All craft will be followed by a recovery boat that will sweep the entire course.

Communications will be maintained between all water and land based officials.

No craft are permitted to enter the jet ski area south of the Narrows Bridge. Any craft entering this area will be subject to penalties as per the competition rule book. Failure to comply with these regulations could result in disqualification.

QUALIFYING

There is no qualifying for this event – a warm up session will be granted at the race directors' instruction and time slot on the day.

START

The start will be a beach start, both competitors in the craft, engines running motor in neutral, Starting one by one with a 5 second gap between each craft.

A "NO GO – Jet Wash" zone will be established behind the boats for safety reasons.

RACE PARTICULARS

- 1. Craft will start as per the section above
- 2. The course will be set out as per the race directors' advice and will be a loop from the club rooms towards canning bridge and back.
- 3. Turn boats will be established along the river you must pass the turn boat on the OUTSIDE
- 4. All craft are to have GPS timing fitted and details logged with race control prior to commencing the start of the race and must carry at least 1 mobile phone.
- 5. Tow rope and ores must be fitted to all craft
- 6. The race will consist of one complete lap of the course with potential for a post-race fun event at the club waters (tbc on the day)
- 7. Upon completion vessels are to land back on the beach in a safe manner.
- 8. No refueling is allowed.

RESULTS

Results will be a combination of actual position across the line with the addition of time penalties applied based on any over speed events logged by GPS. The over speed events will add to you finished race time and once all penalties are applied the places will be announced.

Over-Speed Penalties

0-60Km/hr - Nil Time penalty for operating up-to or at the maximum speed of 60Km/hr

61-65Km/hr - + 5 seconds per breach exceeding 5 seconds in time

65-70 Km/hr - + 10 seconds per breach exceeding 5 seconds in time

70Km/hr - Disqualification from the race and championship points for the round

Trophy's will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Championship points will be awarded as per Competition Rule 1820.
