SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Dinghy's, Tubs & F8's

The Outback Regatta Race is a closed event conducted under the competition rules of The Power Dinghy Racing Club of WA.

The race director(s) may make a ruling on any matter not specifically covered by the competition rules or supplementary regulations contained in the publication.

The Outback Regatta is round 4 of the Club State Championship and will carry points as per rule 1822.

Jump start procedures as per competition rules 1009/1013.

Only 2 heat restarts shall be allowed.

All engines shall be switched off for all beach starts unless otherwise directed.

All craft incurring breakdowns or flips will be allocated 5mins to restart their engines before beach start or mill start green flag goes up from the time the craft entered the pits or reached the beach.

If a craft races in multiple classes they are only eligible for competition points for one nominated class.

Any podium finishes will be recognised in each class but point allocation will be as previously stated.

Failure to comply with these regulations could result in disqualification.

Please note that we are visitors to Lake Towerrinning and must follow all rules and directions given.

All vessels must travel in a counter clockwise direction only and stay within the allocated area.

Freestyling (Minijets).is not permitted in the ski area.

Beach landings are not permitted.

All craft will be subject to scrutineering prior to competition (including F8's & Tub's) Standard and Super Standard entrants will be subject to a carby check prior to competition.
