SATURDAY 28th January - Formula 8"s and Bathtubs.


 $\underline{Scruitineering}$ - 8.30 am in the Pit Area. $\underline{Briefing}$ - 9am in Pit Area.

<u>Pit Area</u> - Located at the right hand end of the course (under rail bridge). All craft must keep left when passing under the bridge. This must be done at idle speed as the bridge is low. Vehicular access is limited so please remove them to the parking area marked as soon as possible.

<u>Course</u> - As per attached plan (counter clockwise). Approximately 320m circut. The left hand end of the circut is fairly tight due to overhanging trees and will require some driver skill. The course is located at the east of the rail bridge (turn right onto Peel Tce).

Parking - There is no road side parking available. All vehicles must use the area marked.
