COMMODORE'S REPORT.

The suggestion was made at the August General Meeting and came about as a result of a number of issues relation to the Avon Descent which are considered unsatisfactory. Most of these relate to safety however lack of prizemoney is also an important factor.

Are you aware that Northam's Avon Descent Association had a turnover in excess of \$110,000 in 1987 yet offered power boats prizemoney of no more than \$600 per class.

The following people have volunteered to join an "ad hoc" Committee to initate arrangements for the new race. are David Dodd, Mario Ambrosino, Kim Epton, Glen Skewes, Paul Tregurtha and Mark Whately. Their appointment and that of other persons who wish to also serve on this Committee will be ratified at the September general meeting.

Obviously a very important consideration for all power dinghy racers is - "Will the new event get enough publicity?" One of the factors which allows so many of us to keep racing is sponsorship, however small. The publicity generated by the Avon Descent is important to these sponsors.

The need to assure this publicity was taken into account by the Committee and the necessary arrangements have been made.

The Committee is well aware of the effort required to stage an event of this magnitude (without being told by a representative of the Avon Descent Committee) but is confident that if the skills, talents and expertise of Association members are freely offered to task will be easily accomplished.
