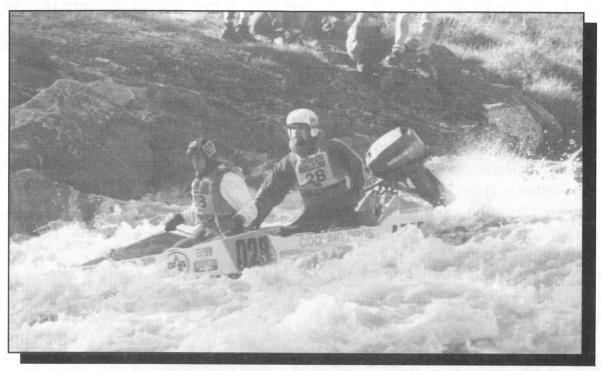

MOORE RIVER BALDIVIS REPORT

The Moore River Sprint should probably be named the "Clayton's Race", because once again it was cancelled due to the low water levels. Perhaps consideration should be given to staging this event in late June!!

The alternative event was once again Baldivis and the weather was great, for a change. It was extremely pleasing to see 21 boats at this event – owing to such short notice and being Father's Day. The 8hp standard class certainly takes the cake with 15 boats charging to the 1st buoy and the jostling for positions was the highlight of the day. The second highlight was the effort of lan and son Todd, with Todd's new 8hp Suzuki, straight out of the box, clean up in all three classes. It was so obvious that it raised more than a few eyebrows, I would be surprised not to see a few more on the racing circuit.

The "Bullet Boys", Mick and Dennis really pulled one out of the hat. They had motor problems, firstly their plugs were arcing, having fixed that problem, the boys then proceeded to make up for lost time, but alas, their motor just stopped! This happened not only once but six or seven times, foul fuel the answer. Mick and Dennis were not slack – they just happened to cop some lousy petrol from the bowser.

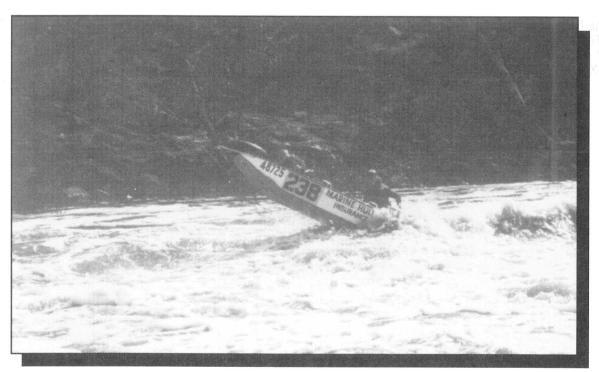

BLAST FROM THE PAST

Participants in the Darling Descent '82, the longest boat journey ever undertaken in Australia's history, kept notes on the event of the day. Mario Ambrosino's contribution on the third day of the trip included this entry:

"At the fuel stop I changed boats and went with my good friend George (Foward) the tireless motor mechanic but the mad boat driver. As usual we were going at full speed. Two boats had stopped around a curve in the river. The only way through was between two trees. We hit a stump. The boat was thrown to the right. I hit my head and face against a tree on the left, got thrown out of the boat, went underneath it with the motor still going and the boat climbing up my shoulder."

Mario's concussion was just one of a number of injuries which included broken ribs (Kim Epton), near drowning (Mark Whittome), injured leg (Adrian Malloy), broken starter motor (the bus). The expedition was the first navigation of the Murray-Darling river system and covered 3,500 kilometres in 14 days.
