

RULE PROPOSALS

- 1.I propose that specification 3.7 be deleted and replaced with the following 3.7 Any outboard motor manufacturers aluminimum alloy propeller may be used with any modification. A propeller made of any other material shall not be used or carried in the boat.
- 2. I propose that Dinghy Specification 7.1 (Safety Rope) be changed to read "a minimum of one fifteen (15) metre length of nylon or poly rope of not less than 8mm...."

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING - 11TH APRIL, 1994




