BALDIVIS RALLY 1995 - RESULTS

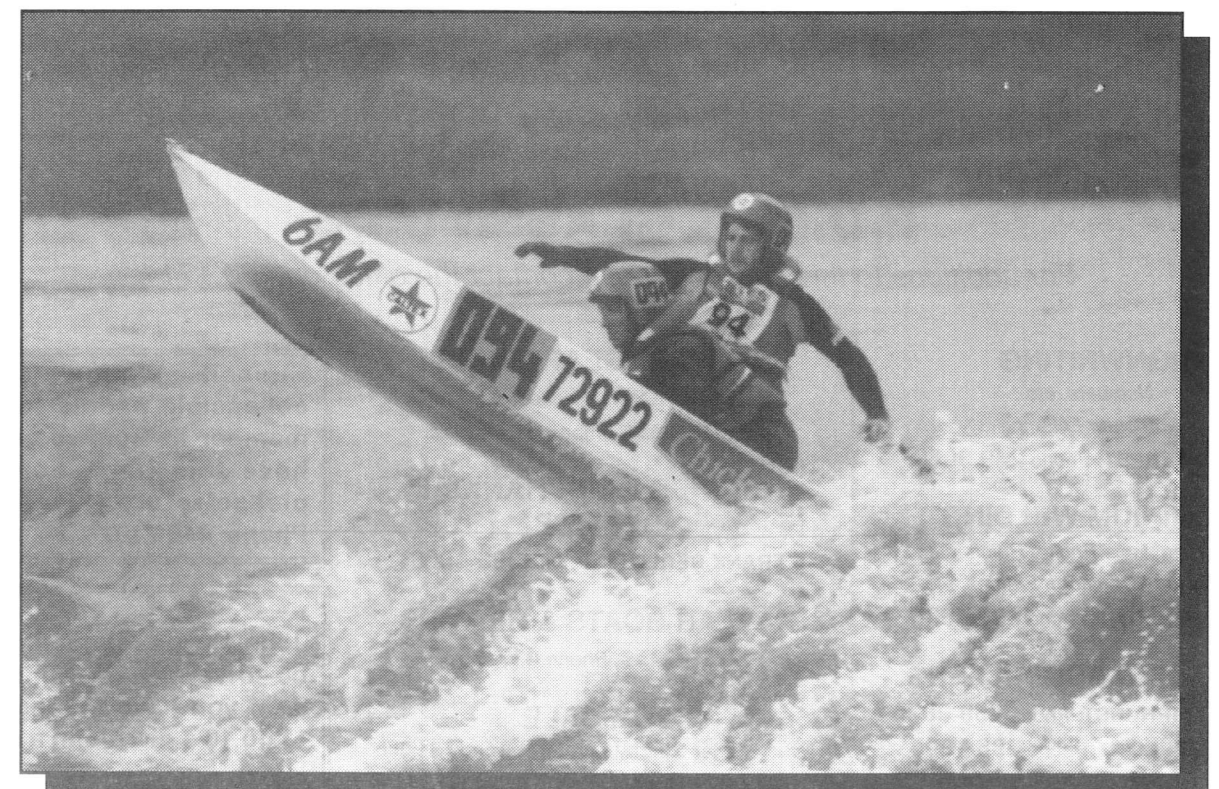
