PROPERTY OFFICER - Responsible for security, maintenance and storage of all Club equipment. Needs to have room for Club trailer plus storage of bouys and other bulky gear. Must be prepared to put time into cleaning, repairing, replacing equipment and advise and arrange new and replacement equipment.

PUBLIC RELATIONS OFFICER - Responsible for promoting the sport, obtaining favourable publicity and producing a monthly newsletter. The only contact with the Club for some members is the newsletter thus essential we have an enthusiastic PR officer. Big job - No newsletter, no Club! RACE REPORT

1997 ALLBUILD BURSWOOD ENDURO

Four pm Saturday - the day before the Enduro, and several members have taken advantage of our access to the Burswood foreshore to do a few practice laps and work out some fuel consumption figures. Meanwhile the race organisers and helpers set out the pit area, marked the course, set up registration and sausage sizzle, it was after dark before all the preparations were finished and we settled down for the night.

The early preparations were well justified as the first competitors turned up at sparrow fart on Sunday and from then on everyone was flat out.

The morning circuit racing ran smoothly enough, Jeremy Paull continued his run of wins in the F8 Mens and Tyrone Wilson took out first place in F10s. Kasey Coates showed that horsepower is not everything by staying with the pack during every heat of F10s despite being 8HP Mariner powered!

Congratulations also to Shane Barden, first in Rookies, stretching his lead in championship points to 40 above Mathew Branson who is close on his heels in second place.

Justin Ferguson stayed upright and kept the bathtub championships on the boil by beating his rivals Bennett and Elliot into second and third places.

With the pits cleared of F8s and tubs and dinghy scrutineering out of the way there was 20 minutes or so of last minute practice and the boats were beached in preparation for the Enduro start. The Le Mans style start, followed

by a period of intense activity as crews fitted props and fuelled their boats was probably the quietest few minutes of the day, the only sound was the slopping of fuel, the odd four-letter word and from one support crew in particular, intense coaching and motivation from the sidelines!

First off the beach with a very smooth start was Frank and John in 124. They were to maintain the lead, looking very comfortable, until their first pitstop. The 10 HP revelled in the long course, each circuit was around 1 min 40 sec, much longer than last year, but their much higher fuel consumption kept them visiting the pit lane more frequently than their 8HP rivals.

The rescue boats were not still for the enderace, there seemed to be a boat upside down or without a crew throughout the 1½ hours of the


Enduro. The GFR team may need to consider painting race ID number on the bottom of their boats as they seem to spend more time that way up. David Brooker and David Johnson went over three times but managed to hang in to the end and still pick up 20 points!

The lead changed hands several times in the later stages and with five laps to go it could have gone to any one of the five

leading boats 144, 139, 124, 117 and 105. Jay Branson was a very surprised, yet delighted recipient of the checkered flag and there were a lot of relieved crews when the 50 laps were over.

Congratulations to all placegetters and finishers and thanks to all the helpers on the day.
