BURSWOOD BLITZ RACE REPORT

EVENT PROUDLY SPONSORED BY CLIFFORD AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSIONS

Twenty nine boats registered for the Burswood Blitz on the 27th of June. Ten new novice crews lined up for their first qualifying race and a few pointers from Frank and Russell on preparing their boats for the Avon. With an extended course set out with two long straights, a dog's leg and a chicane, enduro style heats were the object of the day.

Mayhem and chaos was the best way to describe the first heat of the Burswood Blitz. The relatively flat water became choppy and rough in a matter of seconds. A few crews went swimming, while others battled their way through the conditions. After the finish of the heat it was decided to break the classes up so that the racing conditions were not as tough.

In the 10hp class it was yet another battle between boats 105 and 005 for top position. The Wilson's took home the first trophy by 2 points over Jay Branson and Justin Ferguson with Cliff Hills and Laura Eaton in third.

In the 8hp Sports class, two withdrawals early in the day reduced the field to three. Boat 021 Glenn Dicarlo and Brad O'Neil were too good for the rest of the field, placing first in all heats. Boat 120 and 146 making up the top three.

Eighteen boats in the 8hp Standard class made for some interesting racing. Of those eighteen boats only eight boats made it into the top five positions for the three heats. Keith Outram and Nick Thompson of boat 061 took out top position in both the first heat, over boat 165 and in the second heat, after the crew of boat 033 decided to go swimming on the last lap. The third heat saw the father/son combination of the Paulls in boat 174 take the checkered flag over boat 061 and 165.

A Dash for Cash was held at the end of the day for each class. The boats were started from the beach with motors running and both crew standing out of the boat. The course took them in an oval starting around the speed boat buoys to the right of the club house then finishing with the circuit course chicane in front of the club house. The fastest times for each class were:







One week leading up to the event with the recent rains saw water flowing over Jalbarragup Crossing. However, on race day it had dropped approximately 500mm. It was still more water than last year and the decision was made to start from Nannup.

It was suprising to see only 30 entries, especially considering there was \$1,000 Prize Money up for grabs across all three classes. There was however, a lot of last years entrants attending as either spectators or officials and two of the larger race teams (GFR and Cooling Bros Glass/Seasport) not attending thus putting a dent in entries.

This year we changed a few things about the race in order to involve support crews more and some tasks for the crews themselves so it was not just a flat out speed race without stopping. The basics of the changes were the boats had to make two compulsory stops at checkpoints one and two and drop off a tag which was clipped to their lifejacket at scrutineering. The support crews then had to pick these tags up at the checkpoints together with a black jack card and hand the tags in at the finish line. They could also buy more cards for a dollar and the support crew who had black jack or closest to won \$50 and two bottle of wine. I was very impressed in the way most people followed the instructions.

As far as the racing was concerned the day went fairly smoothly with all boats being accounted for and off the water by 2.15pm. By the time the rescue boats made it to checkpoint one, all boats that had past this point were fin-

ished, except boat 163 Which withdrew at checkpoint four. All bar this casualty came from the first section. We did however have one injury with Ben Fairhurst doing a dam fine job as a deckie but where was the driver. Harry got knocked from the boat and Ben did not realise until they failed to make the next turn. Harry got back in the boat and drove him for some time to checkpoint one. Ben was taken to hospital and ended up on crutches with torn ligaments.

SUNNYSIDE RACE REPORT

EVENT PROUDLY SPONSORED BY: FREEMASONS HOTEL BRIDGETOWN

The weather was perfect, entries were perfect, water levels were perfect, just a PERFECT weekend.

With the river assessed and the decision to run the 10 HP's from Bridgetown, and both 8 HP classes from Sunnyside oval, the scene was set for a great race. Eager racers began rolling in on and before 7.30 am Sunday morning and before we knew it we had a total of 47 entries. Seventeen 10 HP, seven 8 HP sports and a huge field of twenty three 8 HP standard boats.

Scrutineering of the 10 HP's was carried out first to allow time for the crews to travel back to Bridgetown while the scrutineering of the 8 HP classes was carried out. Due to the large amount of entries and the time taken to process start orders, the start time was then changed from 9.00 am to 9.30 am.

With the 8 HP classes away and battling through the trees to the turn around point, the fun was only just starting for the 10 HP guys. With the majority of the boats showing how the basin should be tackled, a certain few made very hard work of it and Mick Chitlick and Brett Barradeen showed that if you're going to go out, go out in a big way. Now everyone knows what the bottom of the boats look like.

On the warmest race morning in years, only 5 boats failed to reach the turnaround point where farm owner Terry Waters had so kindly lit a huge fire for the competitors.

With the rescue boat arriving at the turnaround, and all the boats accounted for at 11.10 am, the 10 HP boats were then headed back downstream followed by everybody else. Because water levels were so high, most all competitors had relatively trouble free runs downstream until the so called dreaded basin. However, novice and experienced campaigners alike made relatively easy work of it apart from a select few. Bill Brehny was undecided of approach channels and did a little friendly tree bashing of his own, whilst Geoff Craine in boat 168 proved it is possible to perform a full somersault in the pike position from a moving dingy.

From there the finish line was a quick dash, and by the times of competitors it was fairly close in all classes.


