PRE RACE SCRUTINEERING

To maintain the highest standard of safety, design, equipment and fittings necessary for power dinghy racing the requirement of the specifications will be strictly enforced.

PRE RACE SCRUTINEERING TIME CHANGE

Pre-race scrutineering will now be at Bridgetown start line Saturday 23rd from 7:00am till 8:30am, if you can not make that time for any reason - please message Brett or Kris direct.

To assist with ease of Pre Race Scrutineering please present your craft in start line condition and have helmets, wetsuits, boots and survival kit layed out, ready for inspection, inside of the boat.

- Fuel tanks must be restrained, motors ready to start with lanyards attached.
- Remember no rear facing sharp items e.g. jack handles, (these must be capped).
- Props for Standard and Super Standard class will be check Pre and Post Race.
- Carburettors will also be marked

Survival Kit Reminder

835 SURVIVAL KIT

If stated in the supplementary regulations each craft entered in an event shall have a survival kit that shall include not less than 400g of high calorific value food (e.g. glucose, chocolate, nuts etc.) and a box of waterproof matches and / or cigarette lighter, one compression bandage, one bandage, 30mls of saline solution (in date), all in one waterproof container.

START PROCEDURES

Start grids will be announced prior to the start each day.

<u>Day One – Staggered Class Start.</u> Standard Class will start in Championship point order 2 boats ever 1 minute starting from <u>9:00am</u> Super Standards will start in Championship point order 2 boats ever 1 minute starting from <u>9:15am</u> Sports will start in Championship point order 2 boats ever 1 minute starting from <u>9:30am</u>

<u>Day two – Fi-Fo</u>

Day two start order will be in the exact day one finish order irrespective of overall time, First in First Out.

Day 3 - Overall Reverse Grid

Times from Day one and 2 will be calculated and the boats will start in reverse grid (slowest first)

Boats will start one boat every X minutes – See table below for X

Number of craft starting (all classes)	Minutes between boats = X
16 or more	1 minute
13 to 15	2 minutes
9 to 12	3 minutes
5 to 8	4 minutes
Less than 5	5 minutes

See pit marshal for details of starting engines before the start.
